Umm an Naser 1,505 According to satellite imagery analysis, Jabalya Camp UNOSAT identified 22,131 destroyed Rafah City structures, 14,066 severely damaged An Nuseirat 1.079 structures and 32,950 moderately Juhor ad Dik damaged structures, for a total of 69,147 Deir Al Balah structures. These correspond to around Abasan al Kabira 30% of the total structures in the Gaza Al Maghazi 'Abasan al Jadida (as Saghir) Strip and a total of 93,800 estimated Az Zahra'a damaged housing units. The governorates 557 Az Zawayda Al Maghazi of Gaza and Khan Yunis have experienced Wadi As Salqa 507 Al Musaddar the highest rise in damage, with 10,280 Az Zawayda new structures damaged in Gaza and Rafah Camp 11,894 in Khan Yunis. Gaza City had the Khan Yunis Camp highest number of newly destroyed Al Fukhkhari structures, with 8,926 in total.
